## THE 2023 LATINO BOOKS INTO MOVIES AWARD WINNERS

We want to salute this years exciting group of Winners from the 2023 Latino Books into Movies Awards. Professionals in many aspects of the film and television industry served as the judges for these awards and they were excited about the possibilities of these chosen books and scripts becoming the type of products that will entertain and education audiences. The entertainment industry is rapidly evolving and finally some of the television and movie productions are paying attention to the Latino market.

In 2010 Empowering Latino Futures, chaired by actor Edward James Olmos, created the Latino Books into Movies Awards for one reason: To help facilitate the production of more television shows and movies by and about Latinos. The Awards are organized by Empowering Latino Futures that also produces the Int'l Latino Book Awards (3,755 authors honored since 1998) and oversees the Int'l Society of Latino Authors. Other programs include the Latino Book & Family Festivals (70 Festivals have been held since 1997); the Latino & American Indian Scholarship Directory (182,000 copies in distribution); and Education Begins in the Home (which has given away over 208,000+ books to underserved youth in just 7 years.
